Dear Families:

Welcome to another year at Brady! I trust that you and your family are well. Last year was very challenging for all of us. We need to be prepared this year for some of the same challenges. Brady and the district are doing everything possible to keep students safe as well as prepare them for their future.

On Monday, you will receive a Preference Survey to determine your student's choice of 100% remote learning or hybrid learning. We appreciate you completing it as soon as possible. In addition, counselors will be calling each student next week as a follow-up and answer questions.

As you know, **Jeffco is starting the year with 100% remote learning for all students for the first two weeks, starting on Monday, August 24.** During that first week the teachers will hold Zoom meetings with each student (both those choosing hybrid and 100% remote) to gather information, set goals, and answer any questions.

Jeffco's current plan is to start hybrid learning on Tuesday, September 8.

Registration

Registration will be done entirely online. Look for details in the near future by checking the Brady website at brady.jeffcopublicschools.org.

Hybrid Learning

Students who choose the hybrid program will have a schedule of two in-person days and three days remote learning. The two in-person days will be alternating -- Monday and Wednesday or Tuesday and Thursday. Fridays will be remote learning for all students.

Daily Schedule for Hybrid Learning

- Arrive between 8:30 and 8:55 a.m.
 - Temperatures will be taken of all students
 - Breakfast provided in the classroom.
 - Students arriving prior to 8:30 will have to wait outside.
- Classes begin at 9 a.m. and end at 1 p.m.
 - Lunches will be grab-and-go.
 - Students need to leave the building after receiving their lunch. Any student not picked up at this time will have to wait outside.
- 1:30-3:45 – Online electives (remote)

100% Remote Learning

- Students will meet five days a week using Schoology.
 - Teachers are available 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 1:30 to 3:45 p.m.

Wrap Around Services

We know that these are difficult times and we understand your family may be facing challenges. Please let us know so that we can support your student.

- The ROAD drop in center will continue to be virtual only until further notice.
- Bus schedules will be available soon on the Brady website.

In closing, I would like to emphasize that we will remain agile in order to keep students and staff safe. Everyone needs to be prepared for changes.
